

# BUCKEYE PAINT HORSE HALTER FUTURITY

Held in Conjunction with the Ohio State Fair - **\*\*\*Be Sure to Make Entries to Ohio State Fair\*\*\***

1. All owner(s) must be members in good standing of the Ohio Paint Horse Club at time of futurity entry. OPHC dues must be paid by a separate check mailed to the membership chairperson, not included with the entry.
2. Futurity Chairperson must be notified in writing of ownership transfer. New owner(s) must be a member of the Ohio Paint Horse Club by show date.
3. All showmen must be paid members of the Ohio Paint Horse Club by show date or before entering the ring.
4. Buckeye Futurity is open to **Regular APHA Paint Registry** weanlings and yearlings only to show.
5. All Yearlings must have APHA Registration papers. A copy of these registration papers must be forwarded along with the futurity entry form to the Chairperson.
6. Weanlings may show without registration papers, but prize money will be withheld until written proof (copy of APHA Registration Papers, or a copy of the letter of intent to register from the APHA Office) of registration has been supplied to Futurity Chairperson, PRIOR TO JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> of the Yearling year. The winnings will be held with the letter of intent from APHA or if an inspection by APHA is necessary until APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> of the Yearling year.
7. Futurity classes offered: Regular Registry Weanling Colts, Regular Registry Weanling Fillies, Regular Registry Yearling Colts, Regular Registry Yearling Fillies, Regular Registry Yearling Geldings, Regular Registry Yearling Longe Line.
8. Buckeye Futurity Entry Fee is \$45.00 made in two payments. First payment due May 15<sup>th</sup> of the current year of \$15.00 per entry. Second payment of \$30.00 is due by the Ohio State Fair Entry Deadline.
9. Late penalty payments will be accepted at double the missed payment(s) until the Ohio State Fair Deadline.
10. Name and registration number of Sire and Dam must be on all entries for identification.
11. Buckeye Futurity payments are to be mailed to the Buckeye Futurity Chairperson, not Ohio State Fair.
12. Entry fees for this Futurity are not co-mingled with any other funds of the Ohio Paint Horse Club.
13. 10% of the entry fees are to be used for futurity expenses.
14. Late penalty payments will be added to appropriate division.
15. The Ohio State Fair will contribute added money equal to Buckeye Futurity entry funds, up to \$3000.00. Money will be divided according to the total number of horses shown.
16. Prize Money:

1 horse	100%

17. Placing will be tabulated using the point system whereby all judges' placings are counted with equal value, however, in case of a tie, ties will not be broken. Prize money will be divided equally among the horses tied for that placing.
18. There will be no refunds or substitutions of any kind issued by the Ohio Paint Horse Club for any reason.
19. All checks will be mailed to winners within 30 days after show, providing the added money has been received from Ohio State Fair and a copy of registration papers has been furnished to Futurity Chairperson. After January 1<sup>st</sup> of the yearling year, if registration papers or a letter of intent from APHA with APHA Work# on it has not been forwarded to the Futurity Chair, or if OPHC memberships of all Owner(s) and Showmen (refer to above Rule 1, 2, 3) are not paid, the prize money will be forfeited and redistributed. Only exception is Rule 6. If you placed 7<sup>th</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> in a class be sure to send a copy of your papers to Chairperson in a case where money was forfeited and paid to the next eligible horse in the class. Any rule not covered by the Buckeye Paint Horse Halter Futurity and the OPHC will be covered by APHA rules.

## **OHIO STATE FAIR ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- A. This Futurity is part of the Ohio State Fair and the horse entered MUST ALSO ENTER THE SAME CLASS OFFERED BY THE OHIO STATE FAIR BY THE O.S.F. DEADLINE.
  - B. If this Futurity has two judges, you must pay two entry fees, one for each judge, for each class entered. Ohio State Fair will payback for the placings under each judge.
  - C. You must reserve a stall with the Ohio State Fair. Each entry must have a separate stall.
  - D. Stall fees and Ohio State Fair Open Class Entry Fee must be made on an Ohio State Fair Entry Form and mailed to the Ohio State Fair by THEIR deadline.
  - E. Attach a copy of your yearling registration papers to the OSF Entry form that you mail to OSF.
- It is the responsibility of the owners of horses entered in this Ohio State Fair Buckeye Futurity to be sure all payments are made in full and on time for the Buckeye Futurity and entries to Ohio State Fair and meet their deadlines. The OPHC Officers, Directors, Chairpersons and Ohio State Fair will not be responsible for any missed payments and/or unpaid memberships. The OPHC Board reserves the right to interpret, amend and enforce all rules. Any decision or interpretation made by the Board shall be final.
