

# OPHC Performance Stakes

## Classes:

**YLL** = Yearling Longe Line\*\*  
**2WP** = 2 Year Old Western Pleasure\*\*  
**3WP** = 3 Year Old Western Pleasure  
**4+WP** = 4 Year & Older Western Pleasure  
**2WTP** = 2 Year Old Walk/Trot Western Pleasure  
**NP2+3** = Non-Pro 2 & 3 Year Old Western Pleasure

**PD** = *Pleasure Driving\*\**

**2HUS** = 2 Year Old Hunter Under Saddle\*\*  
**3HUS** = 3 Year Old Hunter Under Saddle  
**4+HUS** = 4 Year & Older Hunter Under Saddle  
**2WTH** = 2 Year Old Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle  
**BRL** = 2 Year & Older Barrels  
**RNG** = 2 Year & Older Reining

## FEES/DUE DATES:

First payment postmarked by JUNE 1 \$30.00 / class (include copy of registration papers)  
Second payment postmarked by AUGUST 5 \$45.00 / class  
All late entries and penalties due AUGUST 15 See rules #7-9 for late penalty fees

*YLL, 2WP, 2HUS, 3WP, 3HUS and PD will be held concurrently with the corresponding APHA Open class, therefore only regular registry horses may exhibit in these six classes and the exhibitor must also enter the corresponding APHA Open class. First payments for 2WP will not be broken down for Walk Trot or Walk, Trot, Lope Class. When the second payment of \$45.00 is made, at that time you will designate which class you wish to enter. First payment money will be moved to that designated class. If you do not designate with the second payment which class you will automatically be placed in the Walk, Trot, Lope Class. The two year old Walk, Trot, Lope Class will be held concurrently with the corresponding Class as described above. The 2WTP will be open to Solid Bred Paints. Both regular registry and solid paint bred's are eligible for all other classes.*

1. All owners and exhibitors must be paid members of the OPHC by show date. If not a member, send membership fees with your performance stakes entry, but write separate checks for each.
2. All owners and exhibitors agree as a condition of entry to allow drug testing of their horses and automatic disqualification of horses and forfeiture of all awards for refusal to have the test or a positive result of said drug test or illegal practice. APHA rules will prevail.
3. Futurity Chairperson must be notified in writing of ownership transfer. New owners must join OPHC by show date.
4. Non Pro entrants must carry an APHA Amateur card or be a Youth 18 years of age or younger. A copy of the Amateur Card must be forwarded with the entry.
5. Paid up horses are eligible but not required to compete at the Performance Stakes.
6. Walk/Trot Classes are for 2 year olds that **have not shown** in any lope or canter classes prior to and including the OPHC Futurity Show. Walk/Trot horses cannot show in a lope or canter class.
7. **LATE FEES:** If you miss the June 1 payment deadline, you may still enter by August 5 by paying double the first payment plus a \$50.00 late penalty (\$110.00) plus the second payment (total \$155.00).
8. If you met the June 1 payment deadline and missed the August 5th payment you may still enter by August 15th by paying a double the second payment (\$90.00) plus a \$50.00 late penalty (total \$140.00).
9. If you missed both the June 1st and August 5th deadlines, you may still enter by August 15th by paying double the first payment plus \$50.00 late penalty \$110.00, double the second payment plus a \$50.00 late penalty, total \$250.00.
10. Late penalty payments will be added to the appropriate division as added money to the class.
11. Ten percent of entry fees will be used to cover expenses. Checks will be mailed to winners within 30 days of the show.
12. Four judge system will be used. Placings will be tabulated using the point system whereby all four judges' placings are counted with equal value. Ties will not be broken. Prize money will be divided equally among the horses tied for that placing. Prize money percentages are shown below.
13. There will be no refunds or substitutions of any kind issued by the Ohio Paint Horse Club for any reason.
14. Entry fees from these stakes classes are not co-mingled with any other funds of the Ohio Paint Horse Club.
15. Any rules not covered above will be governed by OPHC and APHA rules.
16. Performance Stakes will be held at the Labor Day Weekend Paint-O-Rama & Futurity Show. 1 horse 1 place 100% 2 horses 2 places 60% 40% 3-5 horses 3 places 50% 30% 20% 6-15 horses 5 places 37% 28% 20% 10% 5% 16-25 horses 7 places 36% 26% 17% 9% 5% 4% 3% 26+ horses 8 places 35% 24% 15% 8% 6% 5% 4% 3%
17. **Super Horse Award:** The award will be a sterling silver, custom designed, hand engraved belt buckle. To qualify for this award a horse must be entered, all payments made, and shown in four categories (WP, HUS, Reining & Barrels). There will be no extra entry fee for this award and multiple riders (who meet OPHC membership requirements) will be eligible for each horse. The winner will be the horse with the most points accumulated in the four categories. Points will be tabulated from each of the four judges. For a class of six or more horses, the first place horse will receive six points, the second place will receive five points, etc. Ties will be broken by: 1. Horse with most first places, 2. Horse with one rider opposed to multiple, 3. Flip of a coin. (Yearlings are not eligible for this award).
18. It is the responsibility of the owners of horses to be sure all payments are made in full and by postmark deadlines, including memberships to OPHC. The OPHC, its Officers, Directors and Chairperson will not be responsible for any missed payments and/or unpaid memberships. The OPHC reserves the right to interpret, amend and enforce all rules.
